After completing his officer training in 1992 in the Austrian Armed Forces, he is a militia officer with the current rank of captain. He graduated in 2002 after studying law at the Universities of Vienna and Graz and began working with the law firm CHSH in 2004 after completing his mandatory year in court. He then completed his career as a public notary and took over his own office in Vienna-Inner City in 2022. Since 2008, he has been a member of the Chamber of Notaries and a lecturer at the University of Applied Sciences in Wr. Neustadt in the master's program in the field of civil and commercial law. He is a member of the board of several private foundations in Austria.

He has been a member of the MALTESER Hospitaldienst Austria (Relief Corps of the Order of Malta in Austria) since 1992, he was admitted to the Sovereign Order of Malta in 2004 and has been a Knight in Obedience since 2018. In 2013, he joined the diplomatic service of the Sovereign Order of Malta, where he has served as an Envoy and Minister Plenipotentiary since 2020. In 2023, he was promoted to Knight of Grace and Devotion Grand Cross in Obedience.
